








HOW TO GET HERE



The trainings and the competitions will take place on the slope **Costabella** at Passo San Pellegrino - 38035 Moena (TN)

that can be reached:

By Car

Coming from the A22 Brennero highway, Egna/Ora exit, take the state road 48 delle Dolomiti towards Val di Fiemme – Val di Fassa to Moena and then take the provincial road 346 del Passo San Pellegrino (60 km). Otherwise, from the exit Bolzano Nord, take the state road 41 towards Vigo di Fassa and then go on towards Passo San Pellegrino (55 km).

From the A27 motorway, exit Belluno/Ponte nelle Alpi towards Agordo, then take the provincial road 346 del Passo San Pellegrino towards Moena (60 km).

By Train

The main train railway stations that are the closest to Val di Fassa are located in Trento and Bolzano. From here it is possible to reach the valley by taking the public buses of the Trentino Trasporti (Trento) and SAD (Bolzano), or by making use of a local private transfer.

FIS RULES FOR SKI CROSS

4.2 Entry procedure and Deadlines

Preliminary Entry: 28.12.2024

Final Entry: 27.01.2025

Each National Ski/Snowboard Association has to announce to the Organisers the expected total number of team members (competitors, coaches, accompanying persons and service personnel) by the deadlines fixed and announced (40 days before the first competition day) in the OC invitation.

Confirmation of Final Entries with Arrival and Departure

Not later than 10 days before the 1st competition day the NSA must inform the OC of its final entries (Names, FIS Code and Gender) with their arrival and departure dates.

Adjustments to final competitor entries and rooming needs can be done up until the entry deadline (10 days before the competition day). The same can be done for Team Officials.

The change of the entire team ratio (competitors, officials, service personnel) may not exceed 20% of the original number. Teams that exceed 20% have no right for the reservation or the guarantee of the official rate. For Teams which cancel more than 20% the organiser may ask a cancellation fee up to the official room rate for the cancellations exceeding the 20%. The Organiser may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Association concerned.

4.3 Accommodation & Payment of expenses

Accommodation (half-board, max. 2 people per room/2 beds) will be charged at a maximum of CHF 80 including tourist tax, credit cards and bank fees per day per person (FIS Rate) to all competitors and team officials per country.

Accommodation must be paid at the Race Office before TCM on Thursday and Friday after 16.00

























4.3.2 Quota for Officials

The quotas for the payment of lodging, food are calculated on the basis of the World Cup Quotas.

Team Size Ski Cross:

- 1-3 competitors 5 officials or accompanying persons
- 4 competitors 6 officials or accompanying persons
- 5 competitors 7 officials or accompanying persons
- 6-7 competitors 9 officials or accompanying persons
- 8 or more competitors 14 officials or accompanying persons

4.3.3 Additional officials

For additional officials or "accompanying persons" as well as for service personnel of the National Ski Associations, the maximum price that can be charged for accommodation and half board must not exceed CHF110 including tourist tax, credit cards and bank fees. or the equivalent in another currency, per day. The number of those officials is limited to 25% of the total quota.

4.3.4.1 Ski Racing Suppliers (SRS)

Ski service professionals of a SRS member company which are not directly related to a national team must be entered by their company, using the FIS online entry system mandatory, based on the actual SRS name list.

SRS can distribute the following maximum quota of 12 SRS accredited professionals to their SRS member companies for a Ski Cross event. For these SRS service professionals, the maximum price that can be charged for accommodation with half board incl. must not exceed CHF 110.- per day/ person in a double room or CHF 150 per day in a single room (or the equivalent) including tourist tax, credit card, bank fees.

4.3.6.1 Single Rooms

All teams shall be provided with 2 single rooms at the FIS rate according to Rule 4.3.6. Allocation of additional single rooms per team is provided at a rate of 120 CHF:

3 or 4 officials = 1 additional single room

5 or 6 officials = 2 additional single rooms

7 or more officials = 3 additional single rooms

If more single rooms are requested, this will be subject to availability and local market rates will apply.

4.6.2 Prize Money

The official prize money payout list for the season 2024/25. The prize money breakdown is in accordance with the FIS rules and all money transfers will be made electronically within 7 business days after the event. In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete at the FIS Member Section.

GENERAL INFORMATION

WAX ROOM

Wax rooms when available are located inside the hotel otherwise, heated spaces for ski preparation are set up by the sport centre (soccer field) in Moena.

PARKING

All teams will be provided with parking passes according to their team size in the parking lot near the chair lift Costabella. The passes will be handed out together with accreditation at team's arrival.

ACCREDITATION

All officials and competitors will receive an accreditation card from the Organizing Committee providing free access to the competition site. The card must be worn all the time.

LIFT PASSES

Lift passes are provided by the Race Office upon arrival.

BIBS

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official training and competition.

ACCIDENT/INSURANCE

All competitors must have their own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee declines all liability for any accident of equipment damaged during trainings and competition.

ANTI DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.

FLUOR CONTROL

FIS confirmed full implementation of the fluor wax ban as of 2024/25. There will be tests to ensure that the fluor wax ban is being complied with.
