AUTUMN IN VAL DI FASSA: THE BEAUTIFUL SEASON

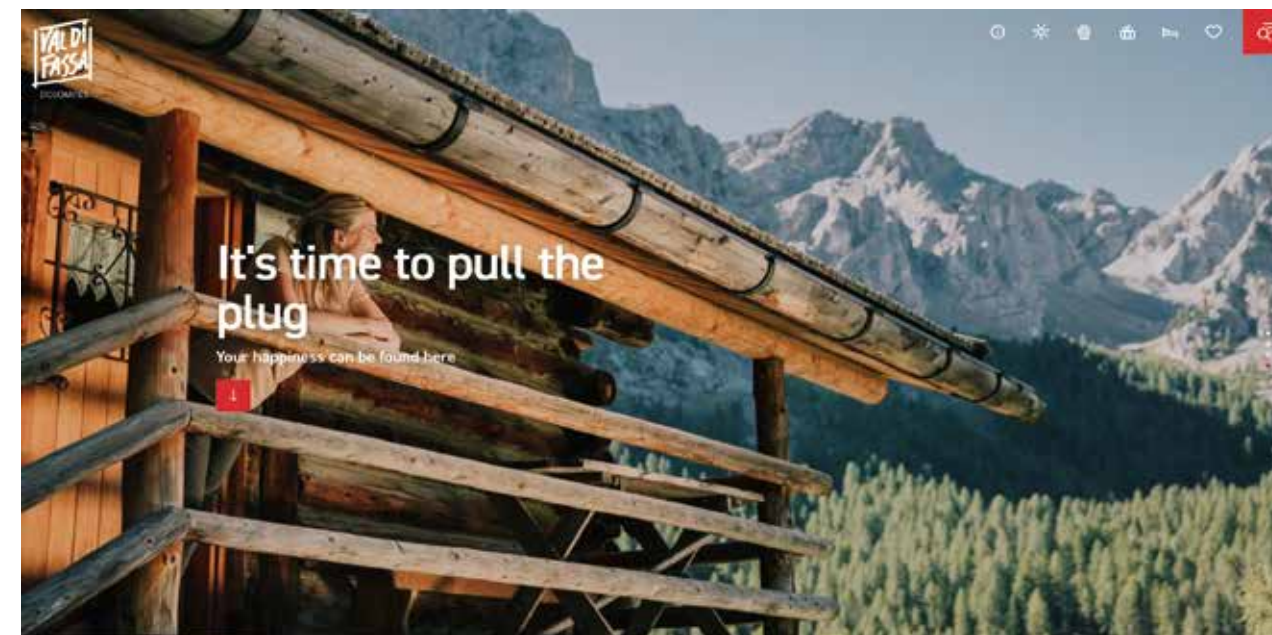
